I love that my child can learn and engage independently without any pressure.

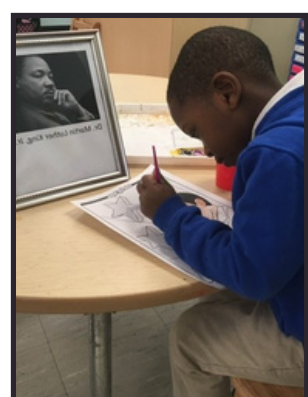
